Celebration Intercessor Guidelines

Our motivation must be relationship, communing with God, anything else places us in the precarious position of simply "using" God. When our focus is on true communion and the pleasure of friendship we will be in a relationship where serving one another flows naturally. We are creating a culture of honor at Celebration, what better place to begin than with Papa, Jesus and Holy Spirit. When we begin with being with Them we settle into a position of faith and trust which creates space for Them to move in unexpected and miraculous ways.

These are our foundations for intercession:

1. Begin with worship & soaking – begin with being with God. (Ps 46:10; Prov 3:5-6)
2. Start with the Bigness and Goodness of Papa God (Matt 6:9)
3. Ask Holy Spirit how to pray (Lk 12:12; Jn 14:26)
4. Do what He says and then leave it there. Don't carry things, don't do more than He says. Remember, these requests are not yours to carry! We are to bring the burdens and leave in rest (Matt 11:28-30)
5. When you get anything specific that the rest of us should know about, let the leader know, so we can pray together in unity. (Debbie Healy leader at this time)

6. If you get something that is negative "flip it" to the positive (what Papa says). You can let me know if there is something the Senior 5-fold leadership should be made aware of and I will make sure that one of them connects with you to be advised. They will be the ones to take action if needed.

7. If you have a prophetic word concerning a request, forward it to me to pass it along. It may be that several of you will have words that connect.

8. End with praise and laughter; end in rest! (Rom 14:17; Isa 52:8-12)

9. Confidentiality

As intercessors, there will be times when we will pray for some very personal and private matters so it's important to be able to hold the requests in confidence and not talk about them with anyone else, even spouses or other intercessors. (Isaiah 62; Jer 31:6-)

10. The power of agreement.

We have the power of life and death in our tongues. Our agreement is always with Heaven and what God is declaring. It's important to watch our language, without knowing it we can get into negativity, fear, judgment and control. God's in charge but doesn't control or manipulate us into choosing Him. He is never afraid. It can be easy to slip in unawares, so its great to have others around us who will help us shift out of negativity or fear should it try to creep in.

Each of us have different focuses in prayer, different passions that Holy Spirit has given to us, and there will be opportunities for each of us to lead the others in what God's heart is.

It's important to stand together and watch from our part of the walls and be those who declare what we are seeing and hearing from Papa, Jesus and Holy Spirit.

There will be times for us to get together to pray for Celebration, for the region, for what is on Papa's heart. There will be opportunities for prophetic acts, trips, and so much more!
